DAY 1: MAKER MONDAY

YARN-WRAPPED APPLES



ACTIVITY/CONCENTRATION

Description of Activity:

- **STEP 1:** Have students use pencil or black marker to trace the apple template onto cardboard.
- **STEP 2:** Use scissors to cut out the apple shape.
- **STEP 3:** Give each student a very long piece of yarn, color of their choice. Show them how to hold the end of the yarn in place on the back of their cardboard apple while using their dominant hand to wrap the shape with the yarn in all directions.
- **STEP 4:** Try to cover the entire apple with the yarn.
- **STEP 5:** When students reach the end of their yarn, have them carefully tuck the end into the wrapped yarn and secure with a dot of glue.
- **STEP 6:** Give each student a tiny twig to add to the apple to make a stem. Secure with glue.
- **STEP 7:** Add a green paper leaf. Students can draw this and cut it out with scissors. Secure with glue.
