While the lesson plan incorporates many different Pennsylvania Learning Standards, it focuses on the key learning area of "Science and Art". DANCING SPIDERS



ACTIVITY/CONCENTRATION

Description of Activity:

- STEP 1: Distribute small pieces of cardboard to students and have them trace
 the outside of a roll of packing tape or masking tape onto the cardboard using
 a pencil.
- STEP 2: Have students cut out their circles using scissors.
- **STEP 3:** Help students punch 4 holes on each side of the circles. (This is where the plastic ties will be inserted.)
- STEP 4: Distribute 8 black plastic ties to each student.
- STEP 5: Show them how to insert the plastic ties into each hole from the bottom, then loop them through to make eight "legs" for the spider to stand on.
- STEP 6: Have students use glue to add googly eyes to their spider's faces.
- STEP 7: Turn on music and have students move their spiders to the beat of the music!
