DAY 1 – SUMMER WEATHER



ACTIVITY/CONCENTRATION

EARLY DROP OFF - ARRIVAL ACTIVITY

During this free time, students will select and use toys or games associated with the daily theme.



DURATION/SCHEDULE

180 minutes - 6 to 9 a.m.



ACTIVITY/CONCENTRATION

READY, SET, LEARN

Hold a class discussion about summer weather. Ask the questions that are listed below and discuss the summer season with the students.

Ask the following questions:

- "Do you know when summer starts?" Answer: Summer starts on June 21st and ends September 22.
- "What weather do you like the best?"
- "What is the difference between the weather in the four different seasons?"
- "What is 'summer weather'?"
- "What are your favorite summer activities?"

Discuss the activity that is to be completed each morning for the next week:

Weather Journals: each day, during the morning time, the students are to go outside and check the weather. The students should fill in the necessary information independently then pass out clipboards and the weather predications activity pages. Have the students decorate their journals with a few crayons with the time remaining.




