ACTIVITY/CONCENTRATION

READY, SET, LEARN

Class discussion about Summer: Ask the students; "What do you know about summer? What is the first day of summer? Which holidays happen during the summer months? Why don't we have school in the summer?" Allow conversation to flow naturally to get the students engaged in the topic. Continue to ask leading questions to further the discussion. Feed the facts below as needed. If time allows, ask students what their summer plans are; vacation, special trips, family coming in town, etc. If time allows, discuss the other seasons.

Fun Facts:

- One summer holiday is on July 4th, Independence Day.
- The first day of summer is June 21st.
- The last day of summer is September 23rd.
- Fun Summer Facts:
 - July is National Ice Cream Month.
 - July 19th is National Hot Dog Day.
